The MLAIC shall, in carrying out its objectives and in all its activities and functions, observe the principle that muzzle loading shooting be practiced, administered and promoted on a non-discriminatory, non-political, not- for-profit and democratic basis.

On this website, we provide information about shooting sports, competitions, events, etc., specifically in connection with black powder firearms. The site is purely informational, and no personal data is requested.

Objectives

The main objectives and powers of the MLAIC are and shall be -

- a) To promote an interest in historical muzzle loading firearms by competing with them in their unaltered state and to encourage research into the history of such arms and their use. In the categories where reproductions of such firearms are permitted, to ensure that they are verified or proven replicas of such original firearms.
- b) To administer, promote, foster, encourage and arrange facilities for sport.
- c) To arrange competitions and matches.
- d) To arrange for, grant and contribute towards the provision of trophies, records, awards and distinctions.
- e) The procurement and provision of amenities and other conveniences considered necessary for fulfilling the objectives of the MLAIC.
- f) The making and enforcement of rules and regulations, as an integral part of the MLAIC legal framework, to implement and to prescribe procedures to achieve the objectives of the MLAIC.

What personal data we collect and why we collect it

When you access this website, information of a general nature is automatically collected. This information is recorded in the server log file and includes the type of web browser, the operating system used, the domain name of your Internet service provider, your IP address, and similar information.

This is done for the following reasons:

- To ensure a smooth connection to the website
- Ensuring smooth use of our website
- Evaluating system security and stability, and
- For other administrative purposes

Your data will only be evaluated statistically to optimize our website and the technology behind it.

You have the option of contacting us via email, on our website. The data collected when contacting us via email can be found in the respective grid.

- Inventory data (e.g., personal master data, names, or addresses)
- Contact data (e.g., email, telephone numbers)
- Content data (e.g., text entries, photographs, videos)
- Applicant data (e.g., names, address, email, telephone number)
- Contract data (e.g., address, email, telephone number)

- Responding to contact requests and communicating with users.
- Security measures.

For users who are registered on our website, we also store personal information like name and e-mail (username) in their user profiles. All users can ask the website administrator to view, change, or delete their personal information at any time (the username cannot be changed). Website administrators can also view and change this information.

Cookies

The websites only use cookies that are essential for the operation of the site. No cookies are used that collect or even pass on personal data.

When you log in into the delegates corner which is a protected area, we will set up some cookies to store your login information and display options. Login cookies expire after two days, and display option cookies expire after one year.

Embedded content from other websites

Posts on this website may contain embedded content (e.g., videos, images, posts, etc.). Embedded content from other websites behaves exactly as if the visitor had visited the other website.

These websites may collect data about you, use cookies, embed additional third-party tracking services, and record your interaction with this embedded content, including your interaction with the embedded content if you have an account and are logged in to that website.

Use of Google Maps

We use Google Maps on this website. Google Maps is operated by Google LLC, 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA (hereinafter "Google"). This allows us to display interactive maps directly on the website and enables you to conveniently use the map function.

Embedded YouTube videos

We embed YouTube videos on some of our web pages. The operator of the corresponding plugins is YouTube, LLC, 901 Cherry Ave., San Bruno, CA 94066, USA (hereinafter "YouTube"). When you visit a page with the YouTube plugin, a connection to YouTube's servers is established. This tells "YouTube" which pages you visit. If you are logged into your "YouTube" account, "YouTube" can associate your surfing behavior with you personally. You can prevent this by logging out of your YouTube account beforehand.

When a YouTube video starts, the provider uses cookies that collect information about user behavior.



How long we store your data

The data will be deleted as soon as it is no longer required for the purpose for which it was collected. For data used to provide the website, this is generally the case when the respective session has ended.

For users who register on our website, we also store the personal information they provide in their user profiles. This data gets stored until the account got be deleted.

What rights do you have over your data

If you have an account on this website or have written comments, you can request an export of your personal data from us, including all data you have provided to us. In addition, you can request the deletion of all personal data we have stored about you. This does not include data that we are required to retain for administrative, legal, or security reasons.

Social plugins

No plugins to social media plugins are used on our websites. We use only a link which will lead you to Facebook. We are not responsible for Facebook data.

How we protect your data

SSL encryption

To protect the security of your data during transmission, we use state-of-the-art encryption methods (e.g., SSL) via HTTPS. You can recognize an encrypted connection by the fact that the address line of the browser changes from "http://" to "https://" and by the lock symbol in your browser line. If SSL encryption is activated, the transmitted data cannot be read by third parties.
