Remarks

Only slotted screws are allowed with the exception of of special screws for sights, locks and set triggers. All modern style additions such as wood inserts (threaded sleeves) are also forbidden. There is a great variety of special screws (screw heads) for sights, locks and set triggers, which you may see on the pictures below. For any other type, shooters must deliver historical evidence.

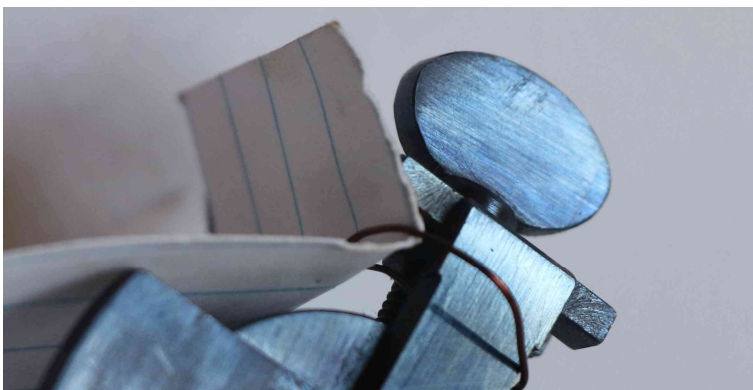

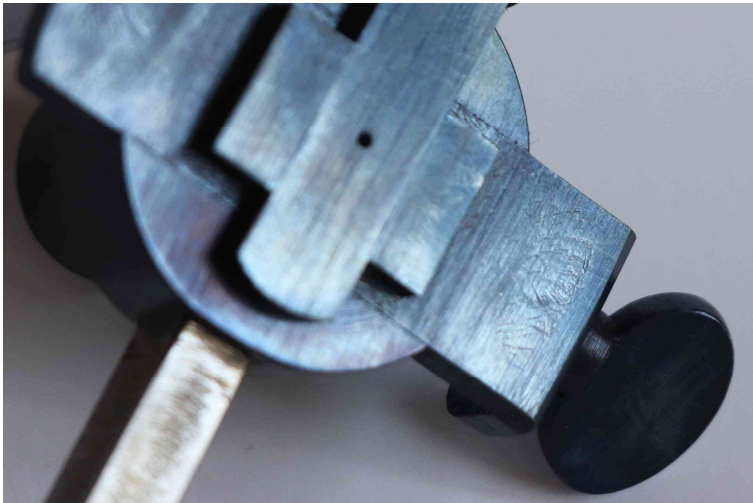
